

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# From the Supreme Commander


#### Listen Up Cooties,





# From the Supreme Surgeon

#### Flu Season 2022-2023

t's that time of year where we are entering the flu season. The CDC has published some key facts about this year's seasonal flu vaccine.

1. Why should people get vaccinated against the flu?

The flu is a potentially serious disease that can lead to hospitalizations or death. Complications from the flu can range from ear or sinus infections, bacterial pneumonia and the worsening of chronic medical conditions such as asthma, diabetes and congestive heart failure. Getting an annual flu vaccination is the best way to protect yourself against getting the flu.



- 2. **How does flu vaccines work?** The vaccine will help your body produce antibodies against influenza viruses that research has determined will be the most common for the 2022-2023 flu season. All flu vaccinations in the U.S. protect against four different viruses: An influenza A(H3N2) virus, an influenza A(H1N1) virus and two influenza B viruses.
- 3. **Flu Vaccine Options.** For people younger than 65, the CDC does not preferentially recommend any age-appropriate, licensed flu vaccines over another during this year's flu season. Options for this group include recombinant influenza vaccine (RIV), live attenuated influenza vaccine (LAIV) or inactivated influenza vaccine (IIV).

**New for this season:** For those aged 65 or older, there are three flu vaccines that are recommended over the standard-dose, unadjuvanted flu vaccines. These vaccines include Flublok Quadrivalent recombinant flu vaccine, Fluad Quadrivalent adjuvanted flu vaccine and Fluzone High-Dose Quadrivalent vaccine.

All vaccines for the 2022-2023 season are quadrivalent vaccines and will protect you from two influenza A viruses and two influenza B viruses.

#### Always check with your Doctor to see which is the right vaccine for you.

- 4. When should I get vaccinated? For those only needing one dose of the flu vaccine for the season, September and October is usually the preferred time to get a flu shot.
- 5. What are the benefits of getting a flu shot?
  - a. The vaccination can keep you from getting sick with the flu.
  - b. The vaccination has been shown to reduce the severity of illness in people who get the flu shot but still get sick.

- c. The vaccination can reduce the risk of being hospitalized with the flu.
- d. The vaccination is an important preventative tool for people with certain chronic health conditions.
- e. By getting vaccinated, you can protect the people around you.

Please take care of yourself this flu season and get your flu shot.



t was great to see so many of you at the Supreme Scratch.


In this issue I just want to remind you how easy it is to certify as an MOC Clown.

# From the Supreme VAVS Chairman

#### Hello everyone.

My team is working to build the MOC VAVS program. Our hope is to get more certified volunteers in as many VA medical sites as we can, and to get certified VAVS Representatives and Deputies in every VA medical center.

I am available to answer any questions you have. In each Cootie edition, I will try to share new information to help out.

What is a VAVS volunteer? There are two types of volunteers. **Regular Volunteers**, who are certified by the VA and have one or more regular assignments in their local VA Medical Facility. Then there are **Casual Volunteers**. These Cooties only come to special events and do not have a regular assignment.

Two regular assignment programs the VA is building up are **Ambassadors** and **No Veteran Dies Alone**. Ambassadors are responsible for greeting veteran patients who come to the VA and help them find their way around the facility. This is not a big deal in the smaller facilities but is critical in the much larger locations.

Cooties assigned to No Veteran Dies Alone will work in the Palliative care unit. When a veteran patient is coming to the end of their life, these volunteers sit with them doing what ever makes them comfortable. The volunteer might read to the patient, talk with them, or sit quietly next to the bed. But, they ensure the patient feels as peaceful as possible and knows someone cares and is with them to the end.

You should check with your local VAMC to determine what volunteer slots are available in your area.

I'll talk to you again soon.

#### Mot Ceneral Order Of

#### 1 August 2022

- 1. Having been duly elected by the members of the Military Order of the Cootie, I, Dwight Hora, hereby assume command of the Military Order of the Cootie of the United States. All previous Supreme appointments have now expired. Cooties will now revert to their previous and proper tassels.
- 2. Notice is hereby given that the logo, bug, official seal, hat and the name Military Order of the Cootie are trademarked and copyrighted property of the Supreme Pup Tent, Military Order of the Cootie of the United States and may not be used without the express written consent of the Supreme Pup Tent. Violators of this order will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
- 3. Supreme Headquarters is established as being located at 604 Braddock Ave., Turtle Creek, PA 15145. Office hours at Supreme Headquarters are from 9 am to 5 pm Monday through Friday, Eastern Time. Supreme Headquarters, MOC is closed for all Federal Holidays.
- 4. The Supreme Budget was approved by the Supreme Council of Administration on 24 July 2022.
- 5. In accordance with Supreme Policy, all Grands are to inform Supreme Headquarters of the dates and places of any Grand Events so that proper representation may be assigned. Supreme Representations for Grand Events Forms are to be mailed to Supreme Adjutant Tracy Woodman, 1916 Grumann Dr, Tomah, WI 54660 or emailed to mocsupremeadjutant@gmail.com
- 6. Grands are reminded to forward a copy of each of their General Orders to the Supreme Adjutant.
- 7. Each Cootie will be assessed \$2.00: \$1.00 for the Supreme Commander's Special Project (Activity Equipment for the children at the National Home) and \$1.00 for the National Home MOC/MOCA House maintenance fee.
- 8. Pup Tents, Districts, Grands and Auxiliaries are reminded that they are to file IRS Form 990 within five months and fifteen days of the close of their fiscal year. Units whose income for 2020 was less than \$50,000.00 can elect to file Form 990-N, an electronic informational return instead of a paper return. Those units whose income was over \$50,000.00 will still have to file the regular Form 990 or 990T.

- 9. Reporting for all programs are due to their respective chairman no later than 31 May 2023.
- 10. 2022-2023 Supreme Policy was approved by the Council of Administration on 24 July 2022 and is in effect.

# Sky Pilot - Chapiain of the Year

#### Sky Pilot / Chaplain of the Year Program 2022-2023

**Objective:** The Supreme Commander desires that special recognition be given to outstanding Sky Pilots and Chaplains in the Military Order of the Cootie.

**Mission:** The Sky Pilots and Chaplains in the MOC are second to none. Their labor of love brings true credit to the MOC and its programs. The Supreme Sky Pilot or Chaplain of the Year Program is an excellent opportunity to recognize your best Sky Pilot or Chaplain. Sky Pilots of the Pup Tent, Chaplains of the Grand, District or Area, have been recognized at the Supreme Scratch each year as *Supreme Sky Pilot of the Year* or *Chaplain of the Year* since Cootie Year 1975-1976.

#### Selection:

- 1. Selection of the Supreme *Sky Pilot of the Year or Chaplain of the Year* is done from letters of nominations sent by Pup Tent Seam Squirrels, Grand District and Area Commanders, Grand Commanders, and Supreme Council Members to the Supreme Chaplain.
- 2. Letters of nominations are judged by a Select Committee of no less than three people who are NOT members of the MOC or VFW, but who understand fully the work or labor of the Chaplain. Any Sky Pilot and Chaplain previously selected as Sky Pilot of the Year or Chaplain of the Year on any level is not eligible for recognition a second time at that level. However, if they are honored at one level, they can be honored at another.
- 3. Nominations letters should be written on MOC letterhead.
- 4. Letters postmarked after 15 May 2023 will not be considered. Nomination letters may be mailed between 1 June 2022 and 15 May 2023.
- 5. Letters of nomination should contact facts, not just words. We have Sky Pilots and Chaplains who do great work in this, and our parent, organizations. So please nominate them and get them recognized by sending your letter to the Supreme Chaplain.
- 6. Do not let your Sky Pilot or Chaplain down. Please make a nomination for this honor. If you don't nominate them, they may not be recognized.

# insigniful inustrations

#### THE INCREDIBLY STUPID ONE

n June 1967, Douglas Brent Hegdahl appeared at the Navy Recruiting office in his

hometown of Clark, South Dakota to enlist and fight for his country. As Doug spoke to the Navy recruiter, he explained that he had only one stipulation. He wanted to go to Australia.

The recruiter produced orders assigning him to the USS Canberra, a missile cruiser, named for Australia's capital city. "With a title like that, the ship's bound to stop near its namesake," the recruiter told him. That was good enough for Doug, so he signed on the dotted line.

After completing boot camp, Doug Hegdahl assumed duties on the missile cruiser. Early one morning (0330) Hegdahl awoke to prepare for his watch in the aft ammunition handling room at 0400. But before beginning his watch, he went on deck to get a bit of fresh air. This was a fateful decision. For the Canberra was about to begin shelling North Vietnam from just

three miles off its coast in the Gulf of Tonkin. Once shelling commenced, the blast from the ship's eight-inch guns knocked Doug overboard.

The thunderous guns drowned Hegdahl's cries for help as the Canberra steamed out of sight. Fortunately, Hegdahl remembered his water survival training. He removed his dungarees and used them as a floatation device and waited to be rescued. A Cambodian fishing boat picked Hegdahl up and turned him over to North Vietnamese officials.

Believing he might be a CIA agent – he was too tall to be a pilot, the officials sent Doug to the infamous "Hanoi Hilton" for interrogation. After several weeks of abuse, he employed a strategy of "playing stupid" before his captors. For instance, Hegdahl convinced his captors that he was their equivalent of a "poor illiterate peasant." His portrayal was so convincing that he earned the name "the incredibly stupid one."

Believing he posed no threat to them, the guards allowed Hegdahl free range of the camp to sweep it clean. They even gave him glasses to see better. But Hegdahl used his reputation as an idiot against his captors and for the good of his fellow prisoners.

He disabled all the prison's trucks by contaminating their fuel lines. He committed to his phenomenal memory all the details of the camp – its layout, location within the city, cell numbers, location of each inmate, schedule, procedures, staff members, and war crimes. He used the strokes of his broom to tap coded messages to other prisoners. He also memorized the names of all 256 of his fellow prisoners – including personal identifiable information about them (rank, dates of capture, names of children and pets).

Since Doug was armed with so much valuable intel, his cellmate and immediate supervisor, Navy Commander Dick Stratton, hatched a plan. He ordered Doug to volunteer to be one of the North Vietnamese's "token prisoners" to be sent home for propaganda purposes.

To Hegdahl this was a distasteful order. All the prisoners had bound themselves to an oath not to accept such favors from the enemy. But Commander Stratton knew that Hegdahl possessed critical information that the U.S. Armed Forces needed to know. So, he gave him a direct order to accept the favor and go back to America.

Once he arrived in America (1969), Hegdahl divulged all his critical intelligence. The military discovered that 256 officers who were listed as missing or presumed dead were actually alive! He also revealed the horrific conditions and the torture they endured while in captivity. He described in detail the layout of the prison and its daily routines.

Multi-millionaire, Ross Perot, flew Hegdahl to Paris so he could appear before the North Vietnamese delegation at the peace talks. There he accused them of mistreating their prisoners – describing in detail the tortures their guards inflicted upon American captives. This resulted in a wave of political pressure from around the

world against North Vietnam. Almost immediately the Hanoi Hilton's quality of life improved for the American prisoners. More and better rations, better treatment, and the cessation of torture followed.

But Doug Hegdahl did tell the delegation one huge lie. He accused the North Vietnamese of murdering his former cellmate, Commander Stratton because he had embarrassed the guards in a photo. Why did Hegdahl tell such a lie? He knew it would place pressure upon North Vietnam to produce the commander alive – and well. It worked. The North

Vietnamese made sure no evil befell him. They ensured that, when Commander Stratton was released, he would be in perfect health – minus the scars they inflicted on his body.

After his release, Stratton wrote this tribute to his former cellmate. "The incredibly stupid one," my personal hero, is the archetype of the innovative, resourceful, and courageous American Sailor. These Sailors are the products of the neighborhoods, churches, schools, and families working together to produce individuals blessed with a sense of humor and a gift of freedom who can overcome any kind of odds. These Sailors are tremendously loyal and devoted to their units and their leaders in their own private and personal ways. As long as we have "the Doug's" of this world, our country will retain its freedoms."

Doug Hegdahl is also a supreme example of how any of us, under the darkest and most adverse and restrictive circumstances, can still be a blessing to many. It was in the adversity of prison that Joseph was molded into the savior of both Egypt and the inhabited world. It was in prison that Paul's most powerful epistles (Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, Philemon, and 2 Timothy) were written. His imprisonment (at least while in Caesarea) may have also helped produce the Gospel of Luke and the Book of Acts. And it was in prison that John Bunyan penned what was once the world's most read book, apart from the Bible, The Pilgrim's Progress.

If you feel imprisoned by circumstances, family responsibilities, work responsibilities, or perhaps by a military deployment, do not despair. Nor should you shift to autopilot and simply "serve your time." Instead, determine in your heart that, by God's grace and help, you will be a blessing where the Lord has planted you. Seek to grow through your ordeal, so you will emerge from it greater than when you entered it.

**PRAYER:** Dear Father in heaven, please give me the grace, power, and faith to rise to the occasion and be a blessing to others wherever You plant me. Why else do You light a lamp, but to place it in the darkness where its light is needed most? Amen.




